Founded in 1891, the Union Rescue Mission moved to its current location in 1926, becoming a beacon of hope for thousands of Angelenos. As Hollywood boomed during the Golden Age, many aspiring actors and workers found themselves penniless, unable to secure steady work in an notorious for exploitation and inequality. The Mission offered food, shelter, and resources to the overlooked backbone of Hollywood: the laborers, extras, and creatives who weren't protected by the glitz, it was one of the few spaces in segregated Los Angeles that welcomed people of all races, providing critical support to Black, Latino, and Asian workers sidelined by systemic racism.


